Luxury Senior Development Planned in Troon North

The Troon North community in northeast Scottsdale may see a new, 67-unit luxury senior community on a roughly 8.6-acre portion of a 22.26-acre site at the SWC of Alma School Parkway and Dynamite Blvd.

Developer Lifestyle Communities has submitted requests to the City of Scottsdale to rezone the site to allow the construction of Artessa Scottsdale at Pinnacle Peak. Specifically, according to the case information sheet on Scottsdale's website, the company has requested "a Zoning District Map Amendment from Planned Community Center, Environmentally Sensitive Lands, Hillside District (PCC ESL (HD)) zoning to Planned Community Center, Environmentally Sensitive Lands, Hillside District, Planned Shared Development Overlay (PCC PSD ESL (HD)) zoning, including approval of an updated Development Plan."

In 1995, the location was approved for a large grocery store and other retail space. The proposal states that converting the property from the approved but undeveloped retail/commercial use will contribute to the overall quality of life in the immediately surrounding area and, "Integrate new residents with substantial discretionary incomes adjacent to an underutilized struggling retail center to support area small businesses."

Rather than billing the development as a luxury senior condo community, the proposal describes Artessa as an "Age Qualified Equity Contract Retirement Community," which the materials define as "a resident-owned retirement/lifestyle community where age-qualified (55+) individuals buy a residence in the community, pay an entry fee, and a monthly service fee for maintenance and other operating costs. An ECRC offers much of the active, vibrant independent living component of a Continuing Care Retirement Community ("CCRC"), such as Vi at Silverstone, without paying for the option of high acuity assisted living or skilled care services."

Unlike a continuing care or assisted living community, Artessa would have no healthcare services provided on-site, and staff would be available during a standard 40-hour business week, rather than 24/7. Artessa also would not have some of the amenities typically found in continuing care or other types of assisted living development. For example, there would be no on-site restaurant, salon or spa services on the property.

The planned unit mix at the 55+ age-restricted community will consist of 14 casitas, 15 one-bedroom, 35 two-bedroom and three three-bedroom homes. The maximum building height would be 36 feet, and the total open space is planned for 422.4KSF, or slightly more than 10 acres.

Along with the on-site open space, the location is also close to several park areas, including Pinnacle Peak Park, George "Doc" Cavalliere Park and the McDowell Sonoran Preserve.

Planned amenities on the Artessa property include a bicycle repair station, a pool area, outdoor seating, a fire pit, a kitchen area with seating, a movie and game play entertainment suite, a hospitality suite for small gatherings, a wellness studio and a guest suite for visitors. Sidewalks on the site will offer 75% tree canopy coverage to encourage pedestrian activity.

New Mixed-use Presented in Old Town Scottsdale

Last month, **K & I Homes** held an open house to present a planned medical office and residential project near Earll Drive and Civic Center Plaza in Old Town Scottsdale to community members.


The plan, presented by K & I Homes' Kristjan Sigurdsson, would develop the **Clayton Medical Suites and Residences** on a two-acre property converted from five current lots and deliver 124 residential units over four floors sitting atop one floor of medical office space.

Sigurdsson said the application to officially start the approval and development process with the **City of Scottsdale** should be submitted by May 10.

The requests will include a rezoning from business to mixed-use, and the project will be reviewed by both the **Scottsdale Planning Commission** and the **Development Review Board** before going to **City Council** for approval. Since the applications have not yet been filed, no meeting or hearing dates have been set.

Following the April 16 open house, Sigurdsson said he found the attendees to be generally receptive to the proposal.

There was an issue with nomenclature, with one attendee saying he felt deceived since the project is actually planned for five stories, not four as the attendee initially thought. Sigurdsson explained the plan is for four stories of residential over one floor of the office. (Source)

P&Z Advances Major Proposals in Queen Creek

Two recent recommendations for rezoning approvals by the **Planning** and Zoning Commission will advance a speculative industrial and a large single-family housing site in Queen Creek.

V&P Nurseries, owned by **Vlachos Enterprises**, has a 240-acre site at the SEC of Germann and Crismon roads and has requested a zoning change from the current General Industrial zoning to add a Planned Area Development overlay that would "establish allowed building" heights, performance standards, expected infrastructure and off-site commitments," according to the request narrative.

The rezoning would allow for the development of the site as a speculative industrial project known as the Queen Creek Industrial **Campus** or **QCIC**. There are currently no specific projects associated with the proposal.

<u>Local news reports</u> say the request would allow for a tiered approach to building heights ranging from 48 feet at the first tier, ranging upward to 65 feet and then a final tier of 90 feet. Equipment and unoccupied associated structures, such as silos, could reach up to a maximum of 120 feet.

The proposal includes a variety of conceptual and potential development paths for the campus, including:

- Spec Industrial,
- Build-to-Suit Industrial,
- Spec Industrial with Large Build-to-Suit and
- Spec Industrial with Small Build-to-Suit.



Butler Design Group is the design firm, and the request is represented by Withey Morris Baugh.

The other rezoning recommendation covers a 136-acre site at the NEC of Meridian and Combs roads for Bosma Farms, which is planned as an eventual 785-lot single-family residential development.

Included in the request is the potential for a 30-acre park. Should that park not be developed, the space could be used for an additional 135 homes.

There is currently no specific home builder associated with the site, according to Town documents and news reports. (Source)

10 Buildings Planned for Demolition in PMGA Redevelopment

A hangar dating back to World War II and nine other buildings at **Phoenix-Mesa Gateway Airport** will be demolished over the next several months to make way for new development and expansion.

The \$1.4M demolition project will remove **Hangar 24**—built by **Del Webb** in 1942—a decommissioned traffic control tower, four buildings from the 1950s and other structures to free up land for future use.

PMGA officials plan to use the hangar site as a space to eventually expand passenger terminal services.

There are currently four hangars remaining on the property from the airport's former days as **Williams Air Force Base**, which operated from 1941 until 1993. There were originally nine hangars on the base.

The **National Park Service** in 1996 launched a documentation survey on Hangar 24 and two other WWII-era hangars to ensure their history was retained when they were ultimately demolished for redevelopment.

The **State Historic Preservation Office** informed PMGA administrators last year it had no objections to the hangar demolition plan. **Mesa Preservation Foundation** President Vic Linoff has requested that the **Historic Preservation Office** be consulted prior to future demolitions, and Mesa staff representatives have said the City is considering the issue. Legislature Continues Attempts to Boost Home Construction Chances

The latest attempt by Arizona legislators to increase home construction and variety around the state is making its way through the process this week, and the current attempt may have a better chance of becoming law than its predecessors.

Lawmakers working with housing advocates and developers say they are close to reaching a deal with cities that could increase construction of townhomes, duplexes, triplexes and other alternative housing styles on land now dedicated exclusively for single-family houses.

Cities have staunchly resisted past efforts by the **Legislature** to overhaul zoning rules for the development of non-traditional housing. Past bills have either failed to pass or have been vetoed as "too far-reaching."

Under the new proposal by **Rep. Michael Carbone**, R-Buckeye, cities with populations greater than 75,000 residents would have to permit up to 20% of homes in developments of 10 acres or larger to be "missing middle" small multifamily uses.

The **League of Arizona Cities and Towns**—the primary lobbying group for cities in the Legislature—had kept the measure, known as **HB 2721**, tied up in the **Senate** for weeks after it passed the **House** in March. Carbone said earlier this week that a final deal appears to be on the horizon.

Cities and the League were opposed to the initial proposal because it would have required allowing developments up to fiveplex size on any lot zoned for single-family. The fiveplex upper end was eliminated in the Senate, and the terms were scaled back to cover only larger developments and those in local business districts.

Despite past failures and vetoes, some efforts to increase home construction and improve affordability with more options have been approved. **Gov. Katie Hobbs** earlier signed a measure that would allow apartment construction in areas currently zoned for commercial and industrial uses in cities with more than 150,000 residents. Under that bill, large cities will have to allow up to 10% of their commercial, office or mixed-use buildings to be converted and/or torn down and replaced with apartments or condominiums without rezoning if the buildings are not commercially viable.

A separate bill requires cities to approve or reject rezoning applications within six months of submittal and to assess local housing needs every five years.

Despite the successes, there has been little movement on one housing development component strongly advocated by the affordable housing and housing supply communities: **Accessory Dwelling Units**.

ADUs, also referred to as casitas, are small homes on single-family lots. They are allowed in many cities, but advocates and lawmakers want them allowed statewide.

Opponents argue that allowing ADUs might not actually contribute any units to the affordable supply and might instead be used as short-term rentals, which face active resistance from many residents and communities.

Legislators and the League have been in a stalemate over the issue for weeks, with two similar proposals currently stalled as a result. Negotiations are ongoing. (Source)



Lenders Race to Buy Back Distressed CRE Bundles

During the initial multifamily post-pandemic boom, many lenders bundled variable rate multifamily mortgages into instruments called **Commercial Real Estate Collateralized Loan Obligations** as an investment vehicle.

Unlike **Commercial Mortgage Backed Securities**, which are usually comprised of fixed-rate loans and, theoretically, less at risk from interest rate increases, **CRE CLOs** are a vehicle for borrowers in need of speculative financing not available from other sources.

Multifamily mortgage delinquencies have started to accelerate, however, and lenders are scrambling to prevent expanded damage to the market.

The total CRE CLO market stands at \$79B worth of loans. Wall Street had financed investors who bought multifamily communities as value-add opportunities in the recent boom to renovate and raise rents. After the **Federal Reserve** began aggressively raising interest rates in an attempt to slow inflation in the overall economy, investors whose variable-rate loans were bundled into securities started missing or delaying payments.

In 2021, CRE CLO issuances increased 137% over 2019, hitting \$45B. At the time, investors assumed a three-year loan duration would be enough to let them upgrade the properties they purchased and refinance their loans.

Now, however, the debt on which those securities are based is coming due. There is significantly reduced interest in the financing marketplace for real estate lending, overall monetary policy has tightened significantly, and other costs—such as insurance—have exploded.

Those complications and others led to multifamily assets identified as distressed to rise to nearly \$10B by the end of March, which marks a 33% increase since September, according to **MSCI Real Assets**.

The CRE CLO market is now feeling the pinch, since the distress rate for loans bundled into those bonds went up 10% at the end of March, compared with just 1.7% last July.

If the share of bad loans gets too high, the issuers would be cut off from the fees they collect on CRE CLOs. To stop that from happening, those lenders have been buying them back in droves. In Q1 of this year, lenders bought up \$520M in delinquent credit, a 210% year-over-year increase according to JPMorgan Chase & Company.

Complicating matters, some of the lenders that are currently buying defaulting loans are doing so with money borrowed on revolving credit lines. As loans continue to deteriorate in quality, they will have increased trouble accessing debt.


Some analysts have expressed surprise that it hasn't happened already. JPMorgan's Chong Sin said managers are engaging in buyouts to staunch delinquencies, but that is only possible if financing costs remain sufficiently low.

One factor keeping those rates low enough for the moment is that risk premiums, also known as spreads, have tightened significantly on CRE loans over the last six months. There is no way to predict if, or for how long, that will remain the case.

Barclays Pic strategist Anuj Jain expects buyouts to continue as distress continues to rise. That plan could run into trouble, however, if the Fed goes back to increasing interest rates or if it continues to hold off on cutting them.

Because of the volatility, short sellers looking to borrow stock, sell it and buy it back at a lower price are targeting lenders that used CRE CLOs. Because the issuers own the equity portion of the securities, they take the first hits when the loans go back.

Some providers are seeing short interest hitting record levels nearing 40%, and every new ripple continues to reverberate across the entire securitized multifamily debt marketplace. (Source)





Phoenix Continues U.S. BTR Leadership

The U.S. added 27,400 units to its Build-to-Rent housing inventory in 2023, and Phoenix led the nation with 4,030, according to a report from **RentCafe**.

Nationally, unit deliveries were up 75% year-over-year. Another 45,000 units are under construction.

Phoenix's delivery of more than 4,000 units marked a 10-year high and an increase of 164% over 2022. RentCafe says Phoenix has both the nation's newest Build-to-Rent stock and the highest inventory, along with a record volume in the development pipeline.

The report says 75% of the Phoenix metro's BTR stock was completed between 2019 and 2023, with 9,345 units coming online in a five-year span. The current inventory of 12,357 homes can expect to see another 7,236 added before the end of 2026.

Dallas, in the Number Two spot, has an inventory of just 10,554, with 2,694 delivered in 2023 and another 6,481 under construction. (Source)

Housing Starts Dropped in March

March housing starts fell from their February numbers, according to new data from the **U.S. Census Bureau**, with multifamily falling by 20.8% and single-family by 12.4%.

Multifamily starts were reported at 290,000 for March, while single-family totaled 1.022 million.

Year-over-year, March multifamily starts were 43.7% lower, but single-family was up 21.2%, according to **RealPage**.

Multifamily completions for the month totaled 502,000 units, which was down 20% from February and up 4.6% year-over-year. Single-family saw 947,000 units come to market, down 10.5% from February and 8.5% from March 2023.

Total residential permits for the year came in at 1.458 million units, down 4.3% from February but up 1.5% over last March. Year-over-year multifamily permits were down 22.1%, and single-family dropped 17.4%.

Metro Phoenix ranked third in the overall number of multifamily permits issued from March 2023-March 2024 with 17,312, an annual decrease of 3,512 units and 16.9%. (Source)

NAHB Releases 10-point Plan for Housing Affordability

With a nationwide shortage of roughly 1.5 million housing units that is making it increasingly difficult for American families to afford to purchase or rent a home, the National Association of Home Builders has unveiled a 10-point housing plan designed to tame shelter inflation and ease the housing affordability crisis by removing barriers that hinder the construction of new homes and apartments.

"The lack of homes is the primary cause of growing housing affordability challenges," said NAHB Chairman Carl Harris. "Any policy that seeks to improve affordability without addressing the need to increase the supply of single-family and multifamily for-sale and forrent housing is doomed to fail."

Shelter inflation – rent and homeownership costs – is still rising well above a 5% rate, and for the past year, more than half of overall inflation in the economy has been due to rising housing costs. The only way to effectively tame shelter inflation – particularly with elevated interest rates for both mortgages and development/ construction loans – is to build more attainable, affordable housing.

With policymakers at all levels of government looking for ways to provide more affordable homeownership and rental housing opportunities for all Americans, NAHB is offering a plan that outlines initiatives that can be taken at the local, state and federal levels to address the root of the problem – the impediments to increasing the nation's housing supply.

- 1. Eliminate excessive regulations.
- Promote careers in the skilled trades.
- 3. Fix building material supply chains and ease costs.
- 4. Pass federal tax legislation to expand the production of affordable and attainable housing.
- 5. Overturn inefficient local zoning rules.
- 6. Alleviate permitting roadblocks.
- 7. Adopt reasonable and cost-effective building codes.
- 8. Reduce local impact fees and other upfront taxes associated with housing construction.
- 9. Make it easier for developers to finance new housing.
- 10. Update employment policies to promote flexibility and opportunity.

The nation's home builders are committed to doing their part to boost housing production to meet the needs of a growing population, make homeownership and renting more affordable, and elevate housing as a national priority. But we cannot do it alone. By implementing these practical solutions and reaffirming their commitment to housing, policymakers at all levels of government can help fulfill the promise of the Housing Act of 1949, which set a goal of "a decent home and a suitable living environment for every American family."

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March Construction Job Openings Fall by 182,000

The construction industry had 274,000 job openings on the last day of March, according to an **Associated Builders and Contractors** analysis of data from the **U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics' Job Openings and Labor Turnover Survey**.

JOLTS defines a job opening as any unfilled position for which an employer is actively recruiting. Industry job openings decreased by 182,000 last month and are down by 17,000 from the same time last year.

"Construction job openings plunged in March, falling to the lowest level since October 2020," said **ABC** Chief Economist Anirban Basu. "While there are many headwinds facing the industry, including the prospect of higher-for-longer interest rates, this dismal number likely reflects a statistical aberration rather than a legitimate decline in demand. We know that the construction industry <u>added jobs at a rapid pace</u> in March, and both backlog and contractor confidence improved for the month, according to ABC's <u>Construction Backlog Indicator</u> and <u>Construction Confidence Index</u>, respectively.

"We have seen this kind of volatility in the JOLTS data before; construction job openings also plunged last March," said Basu. "Which is to say, on a year-over-year basis, openings are only down modestly. The sizable decline in openings observed in March 2023 and 2024 may reflect seasonal hiring patterns that are not reflected in the BLS' seasonal adjustment factors. Accordingly, these data should not be viewed as a sign of an industry slowdown, at least not without another month or two of data to corroborate it." (Source)


March Nonresidential Construction Spending up 0.2%


National nonresidential construction spending increased 0.2% in March, according to an **Associated Builders and Contractors** analysis of data published by the **U.S. Census Bureau**. On a seasonally adjusted annualized basis, nonresidential spending totaled \$1.19T.

Spending was up on a monthly basis in 10 of the 16 nonresidential subcategories. Private nonresidential spending decreased 0.2%, while public nonresidential construction spending was up 0.8% in March.

"Nonresidential construction spending rebounded in March, ending a streak of two straight monthly declines," said **ABC** Chief Economist Anirban Basu. "The increase was entirely due to increased public construction spending; private sector nonresidential spending dipped slightly lower in March. Despite wavering over the first three months of 2024, nonresidential spending is now up approximately 35% from the start of the pandemic and has outpaced economywide



inflation (+20%) over that span. Ongoing spending strength, driven by both the public sector and the ascendant manufacturing category, continues to support healthy backlog for contractors, according to ABC's <u>Construction Backlog Indicator</u>." (<u>Source</u>)




